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### Marking Scheme

1. a. – The messiah will be born in Bethlehem
- He will rule over Israel
  - His origin is from old/ ancient days
  - He will be born of a woman
  - He will feed his flock
  - He will rule in the majesty/ power of God
  - In his time, Israel will dwell secure
  - He shall be great to the end of the earth/Messiah will be great
  - Israel will have victory over her enemy/there will be peace.

- b. – She was highly favoured among women
- She will bring forth a son
  - He will be called the son of the most high/son of God
  - He will be given the throne of his father David
  - He will reign over the house of Jacob forever
  - The kingdom will be everlasting
  - The Holy Spirit will come upon her
  - The child to be born will be holy
  - Elizabeth her cousin had also conceived in her old age
  - With God nothing is impossible.

2. a. – Jesus came to Nazareth where he had been brought up.
- He went into the synagogue as he usually did on the Sabbath day.

- He was given the book of prophet Isaiah when he stood up to read.
- He opened the book found the place that was written about him and read it to the people.
- After reading he closed the book gave it to the attendant/ sat down.
- Everybody in the synagogue looked at him.
- He told them that the scripture he had read fulfilled in their hearing.
- All people were happy with what he had spoken.
- People wondered aloud saying “Is this not Joseph’s Son.

- Jesus told them that they would ask him to do in his own country things he had done in the country.
- He told them that there were many windows in Israel during the time of Elijah but God sent the prophet to a widow in Zephath/God only healed Naaman the Syrian of leprosy during the time of prophet Elisha.
- They were filled with anger, wanted to throw him headlong/down the cliff.
- Jesus passed through their midst and went away.

- To have companions/personal assistants.
- To form an inner group which should assist him during his public ministry.
- To be witnesses to his saving acts in the world.
- To reveal his person/give a new understanding of his messiahship.
- It symbolized the reconstruction of the twelve tribes of Israel.
- To train/prepare them for the mission after his death.
- To lay a foundation for the establishment of the church
- To continue with the biblical theme of election in which God chooses anyone to serve him.

3. a. – When Jesus came to Mt. Olives, he sent two of his disciples ahead to get a colt which had not been used before.

- He told them if anyone ask why you are untying it, say the master needs it.
- The disciples found the colt/untied it.
- The owners of the colt asked why they were untying it.
- The disciples told them that the Lord needs it.
- The disciples brought the colt to Jesus/put their garments on its back/set Jesus on it.
- As Jesus went along on the colt, people spread their garments on the road where he passed.
- The whole crowd of disciples praised/glorified God joyfully in loud voices for all the mighty works they had seen.
- The Pharisees in the crowd asked Jesus to rebuke/silence the disciples.

- Jesus told them if they keep quiet, the stones would cry out.

b. – Not accuse others falsely.

- Not intimidate/influence others to do/say what they know is wrong.
- Do only what is pleasing to God/not please fellow human beings.
- Strive for justice/fairness regardless of the cost.
- Be careful in judging/accusing others passing judgments.
- Gives examples to others/give guidance.
- Jesus was innocent/ did not deserve to die.
- Jesus is the Messiah/son of god.

c. – They lacked faith in the teaching of Christ

- The tomb was heavily guarded by the Roman soldiers/a big rock
- They were ignorant of the divine nature of Jesus/not understand the teaching that he would resurrect
- The message was first taken to them by women (regarded lowly/idle talk)
- They had witnessed the helplessness of Jesus at the time of crucifixion/had lost hope in him
- They felt ashamed for having denied/betrayed him/wished that it was not true
- It was a new experience they had never seen/heard of people coming to life after death on their own
- They had expected a political Messiah who was to die on dignity/would not resurrect

4. a.- Word of Wisdom.

- Word of Knowledge
- Gift of Faith
- Gift of Healing.
- Gift of working miracles
- Gift of prophecy
- Gift of speaking in tongues
- Distinguishing between spirits.
- Gift of Interpreting tongues.

**Any 8 x 1 = 8mks.**

b. – Believers are the body of Christ

- Christ is the head of the Church
- Believers form the parts of the body
- The body has different organs in the same way the church has different members
- They all need to work together for the well being of the Church

- Every part of the body is needed to make it whole/all parts are interdependent/one part cannot be without the other
- The different Church members are given different spiritual gift by Holy Spirit to carry out God's works
- Believers are united through baptism in the Holy Spirit
- There should be no division in the Church since all believers are members of the body of Christ

- c. – Christians meet for prayers/fellowship together
- They observe a day of worship to honour God
  - They share Holy communion/meals
  - They help those who are poor/ needy
  - They solve problem affecting members
  - They hold joint crusades/rallies.
  - They co-operate by providing Christian programmes in the mass media/resource materials
  - They speak in one voice to condemn evil in society
  - Through ecumenical organizations e.g NCCCK/KCS

5. a. – Human reason experience intuition/free will conscience/faith in God
- The Bible/teaching of Jesus Christ
  - Tradition from Christian community/Church rituals/Authoritative Christian community/Church rituals/Authoritative Christian literature
  - Natural law
  - Situational Ethics/ God revelation
  - Secular Laws
  - African customs/African morality.

- b. – They have seen/experienced incidents of broken marriages/unfaithfulness in marriage.
- In order to pursue their careers/education.
  - They are not ready to take up responsibilities of marriage.
  - Poverty/lack of jobs/inadequate resources to start a family/economic empowerment.
  - Permissiveness allows may to satisfy the sexual lust without marriage commitment.
  - Failure to get an expected/ideal partner.
  - Marriage is no longer a communal duty/it is an individual decision.
  - Religious commitment/superstition hinders one from involving themselves in marriage.
  - Low self esteem/lack of confidence/fear of being jilted/failed relationship.

- c. - Provide pastoral care/guidance/counseling.
- preaching to them
  - Accept them in the church/community.



- Provide them with material help where necessary/provide opportunity.
- Visit them/invite them to visit with them.
- Pray with them/for them.
- Involve them in Church activities.
- Encourage them to get married.
- Invite them to Church seminars on family life.

6. a. – Obey/respect the laws.
- Obey/respect the Authorities.
  - Paying taxes
  - Participate in the democratic process/vote/referendum
  - Support/defend the constitution.
  - Stay informed of the issues affecting the community.
  - Participate in economic activities to generate wealth.
  - Protect the environment/take care of the environment/wildlife.

b. - laws promote harmonious living among people

- Laws govern/safeguard people's property

-They enable people to be involved in various development activities

- Laws regulate power of those in authority/act as checks and balances.

- They ensure the security of the citizens.

- They protect people's rights.

- They regulate taxation.

- Laws define duties/responsibilities of citizens.

- Laws define the identity/culture of the people.
