1(a) Outline Nathan prophecy concerning the Messiah (2samuel 7:3-17)

- ✓ God would ensure the kingdom of David lasts forever.
- ✓ An heir of David would be raised up to sit on the throne.
- ✓ The king would save the people of Israel from their enemies
- ✓ God would always support such a king
- ✓ God would keep the kingdom strong for David's son.
- ✓ God would give Israel their own land
- ✓ God would make David's name great and bless his descendants forever

(b) Mention the events that took place on the night Jesus was born (Lk 2:6-22)

- ✓ When Jesus was born, his mother wrapped him in swaddling clothes
- ✓ She placed him on a manger.
- ✓ There were shepherd's watching over their flocks
- ✓ An Angel appeared to the shepherd's in the region to tell them of the birth of the savior.
- ✓ A great company of heavenly hosts/ angels appeared singing praises to God.
- ✓ The shepherds decided to go to Bethlehem/ hurried off to Bethlehem.
- ✓ They spread the news to about the baby to other people
- ✓ The shepherd returned praising/glorifying God
- ✓ The angel gave a sign on how to identify the baby

c) Give SEVEN ways through which church leaders prepare for the second coming of Christ

- ✓ Preaching good news
- ✓ Living exemplary lives
- ✓ Helping the needy

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- ✓ Condemning evils in the society
- ✓ Sharing in the lord's supper/baptism
- ✓ Confessing Jesus as lord
- ✓ Repenting and asking for forgiveness of sins
- ✓ Being role models
- ✓ Fasting and praying

- 2. a) Giving examples, state the methods used by Jesus to spread the gospel.
 - ✓ Preaching He preached in the synagogue in Nazareth and throughout the country
 - √ Through healing miracle/curing diseases; healing the paralytic
 - ✓ Raising people back to life eg, Jairus daughter
 - ✓ Use of parables parable of the sower
 - ✓ Use of live examples use of a child to teach on innocence
 - ✓ Question and answer, who do men say I am
 - ✓ Use of wise saying; salt is good but if it looses taste its saltiness is no way to make it salty again
 - ✓ House visits Mary and Martha (NB must give an example)

- b) Describe the raising of widow's son at Nain Luke 7:11-17
 - ✓ Jesus went to the city of Nain with his disciple
 - ✓ At the gate of the city he met people carrying a dead man
 - √ The dead man was the only son of the widow
 - √ The mother was accompanied by a larger crowd.
 - √ Jesus felt pity of the widow/told her not to weep
 - ✓ Jesus touched the coffin in which the body lay
 - ✓ Jesus told the dead man to arise
 - √ The dead man set up/began to speak
 - ✓ Jesus gave the man to his mother
 - √ The people were filled with fear
 - ✓ Jesus fame spread through Judah.

c) Identify ways through which the church continues with the healing ministry of Jesus (6mks)

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- √ Christmas pray/preach to the sick
- ✓ Laying hands on the sick/anointing them/any other miraculous healing
- ✓ Providing guidance and counselling services
- √ Visiting the sick
- ✓ Preaching against evil/causes of ailments that interfere with good health
- √ Paying medical expenses for the sick
- ✓ Construction of hospitals/rehabilitation centers

3a) Outline the preparations that Jesus made for the last supper. (Luke 22:7-14)

- ✓ Jesus sent Peter and John to prepare for the last supper.
- ✓ He instructed two disciples to go into the city.
- ✓ He told them that they should follow the man into the house he would enter.
- ✓ Once in the house, the disciples were to ask the owner to show them the guest room.
- ✓ Jesus told the disciples that the householder would show them a large furnished upper room.
- ✓ He instructed the disciples to prepare the rom.
- ✓ The disciples prepared the meal.
- ✓ Jesus together with his disciples sat down in the prepared room.

b) Give six actions of Pilate that showed that he had found Jesus innocent.

- ✓ He wanted Jesus to be released and not Barabbas.
- ✓ He tried to acquit Jesus.
- ✓ He proposed that Jesus be whipped and then set free.
- ✓ He had taken him to Herod for trial.
- ✓ He questioned the people three times on Jesus guilt.
- ✓ He allowed the body of Jesus to be buried decently.

c) Why should Christians be discouraged from taking part in mob justice?

- ✓ It does not give room to reason.
- ✓ It is impulsive /based on emotions.
- ✓ It can lead to destruction of property / life.
- ✓ It is not biblical / lacks love.
- ✓ It can be filled with lies.
- ✓ The victim is denied a chance of defending himself.
- ✓ It is a form of retaliation / revenge.



- ✓ It gives no room for forgiveness.
- ✓ It can lead to bitterness / regret.

4(a) Describe how Peters' life was transformed on the day of Pentecost

- ✓ Peter was filed with the holy spirit
- ✓ He started speaking in tongues
- ✓ He became courageous/defended the disciples that they were not drunk
- ✓ He was able to remember old testament prophecies/teachings
- ✓ He began witnessing the life, death and resurrection of Jesus
- ✓ He called people to repentance
- ✓ He was empowered to perform miracles
- ✓ He took up a leadership role

b) Explain how the unity of believers is expressed in the church as the body of Christ

- ✓ Believers are the body while Christ is the head of the church
- ✓ The body has different organs the same way the church has different believers
- ✓ As each part of the body contributes to the whole. All church members should work for the wellbeing of the church
- ✓ Each part of the body has a part to play same case each member of the church has different gifts for the benefits of the church
- ✓ There should be no division in church since all members are the body of Christ
- ✓ Baptism in the holy spirit unites all believers as one

- ✓ By listening to people's different opinions and enabling them to reach a consensus
- ✓ By discouraging industrial action and calling for a dialogue
- ✓ By giving employees fair wages

- ✓ By encouraging people to do their work diligently and as agreed in the contract
- ✓ Obeying and respecting the authorities at the work place
- ✓ By providing favourable working conditions
- ✓ Giving employees rest/leave from work regularly
- ✓ Showing concern for colleagues personal issues

- ✓ Permissiveness allows men to satisfy their sexual lust-without marriage commitment
- ✓ Marriage is no longer a communal duty but an individual decision
- ✓ To pursue their career/education
- ✓ Fear of being rejected

- ✓ The churches give material support/employment to reduce tensions from poverty
