

## **CHRISTIAN RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PAPER 2 MARKING SCHEME**

1. a) - John will be the prophet of the Most High.  
- He will be the forerunner of the Messiah/ he will prepare the way of the Messiah  
- Hw will give knowledge of salvation to the people of God  
- John will give light to those who sit in darkness and in the shadow of death  
- He will direct God's people to tender mercy of God which they will receive forgiveness of sins

Any 3 x 2 = 6mks

- b) - Both preached the message of salvation / they preached the Good News  
- Both preached about social justice / they condemned social injustice  
- They advised people to repent their sins in order to attain salvation  
- Both condemned hypocrisy in the Jewish society  
- Both predicted what would happen in the future / They foretold the future / Both were prophets  
- John and Jesus encountered opposition from the Jewish leaders  
- Both fulfilled what was prophesied in the Old Testament / Their ministry had been prophesied in the Old Testament

- c) Christians should be courageous in their work, John did not fear to condemn Herold.  
- They should be honest like John who revealed the hypocrisy in the lives of Israel  
- They should be ready to suffer just as John was jailed for the sake of the Gospel  
- Christians should have faith. John had a strong conviction that the Messiah would be coming very soon.  
- John obeyed God by proclaiming His message. Christians should also obey God.  
- Christians should be ready to lead a life of self-denial. John lived in the wilderness  
- Christians should be ready to serve God. John served God by baptizing people and preaching the gospel.  
- John was humble as he acknowledged the greatness of Jesus. Christians should be humble.

2. a)
- Jesus went to Capernaum after the rejection at Nazareth
  - He taught people in a synagogue
  - People were astonished at his teaching because he taught with authority
  - There was a man in the synagogue who had a demon
  - The man cried out to Jesus with a loud voice. Ah! What have you to do with us Jesus of Nazareth?
  - Jesus rebuked the demon and commanded it to be silent
  - The demon threw the man down and left without hurting him.
  - People were amazed
  - Reports about Jesus spread.

- b)
- He should love his enemies
  - Should pray for those who mistreat them
  - A true disciple should give without expecting to be paid back.
  - A disciple should be merciful as God is merciful
  - He/ she should not judge / condemn others
  - He should forgive others so as to be forgiven also
  - A disciple should obey God / should set a good example
  - A disciple should not revenge / not strike back when offended.

- c)
- Advancement in science has challenged the basic beliefs of Christianity
  - There are false doctrines which are opposed to Christianity / cults and spread false teachings
  - Negative influence by the mass media / competition from modern entertainment.
  - Competition from other faiths such as Islam, Hinduism and Buddhism.
  - Different interpretation of the bible of issues such as homosexuality, same sex marriage and lesbianism.
  - Secularization of the society prevents Christians from practicing their faith freely.
  - Failure by some Christians to measure up to the teachings of the church / Hypocrisy is rife in Christianity.
  - Schism in the church especially between the third world and developed countries.
  - The diminishing numbers of people who attend the church / reduction of church membership especially in western world.
  - Lack of adequate training / mentorship of church leaders.

3. a) The healing of centurion's servant.
- Jesus entered Capernaum where the centurion's servant was sick.
  - The centurion sent Jewish elders to plead with Jesus to heal his servant
  - The elders told Jesus how good the man was to the Jewish community
  - Jesus accepted and went with them.
  - The centurion sent his friends to stop Jesus not come to his house for he did not deserve the visit.
  - He believed that if Jesus just gave a command the servant would be healed.
  - Jesus marveled at the faith of the centurion and made his servant well
  - When the friends of the centurion went back home they found the servant healed.

- b) People should not trust in material wealth but in God who controls their lives.
- They should not worry about material needs but trust in God's providence
  - People should be concerned with seeking God's kingdom first before their personal material needs.
  - Material possession should be used to serve and glorify God

  - Concentrating on material possession makes people forget about God
  - Acquisition of material wealth is not bad but how it is possessed and used
  - Those who seek God's kingdom will be rewarded with heaven treasures.

4. a) - A prophet way of life should reflect the teachings of Jesus
- A false prophet will ask for payment for his prophecies
  - False prophets preach peace to please people
  - A true prophet speaks the truth including God's judgement to sinners irrespective of the consequences
  - A true prophet invites sinners to repentance
  - A person under the influence of the Holy spirit will proclaim Jesus as Lord and savior
  - Those with an evil spirit will curse Jesus

- People who are not guided by they Holy spirit by the desires of the flesh

  - Love does not insist on its one way

- c) - Commercializing the gift / some ask for money in order to enrich themselves
- Lying that one has the gift
  - Deception through false witnesses who claim that they have been healed
  - Some people use it to f]popularize themselves / self-glorification
  - Advertising their gifts through the mass media
  - Over emphasis on healing in church more than other gifts like love, prophecy
  - Discrimination against those without the gift
  - Disregard of conventional medicine leading to failure to seek medical attention

- 5.a)
- Human weakness
  - Sexual curiosity
  - Testing fertility
  - Fear of being silted by a boy/ girl
  - Poverty
  - Availability of contraceptives
  - Negative peer pressure and bad company
  - Influence from print and electronic media
  - Frustrations
  - Unemployment drug and alcohol abuse
  - Proving manhood

- b)
- God created both male and female sexuality leads to procreation
  - Sex is sacred and is a gift from God
  - God crated both male and female in his image
  - Male and female complement each other
  - The union of male and female is consummated I marriage not outside

- Sexuality is also for mutual companionship
- The body is the temple of God and should be respected
- One can give up sex or marriage to serve God fully (celibacy)
- Male and female have distinct roles in creation
- Sexual deviation is highly condemned e.g. rape etc

  - Drug abusers tend to have close attachments to groups hence vulnerable to irresponsible sexual behavior in the name of friendship

- For satisfaction and fulfillment
  - For personal development
  - To acquire basic essentials of life e.g. food, clothing and shelter
  - To give life direction, meaning and dignity
  - To provide services for the community and fellow human beings
  - To acquire wealth and status in society
  - To socialize and grow as a member of a community
  - To attain independence so that young people stop depending on their parents and guardians for the necessities of life

- When paid wages on time / a just wage
  - When you pay them according to the labour contract
  - Extra work, extra pay
  - Enable them to rest / have leisure time
  - Equal work, equal pay / no discrimination
  - Provide favorable and safe working conditions
  - By enabling them to undergo personal development and training which can provide opportunities for promotion
  - When you allow them to form associations
  - By treating them with respect and dignity
  - By being considerate to employees grievances.
  - By giving them motivation e.g. salary increments.
