INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES:

- This paper is for use by the supervisor only, in consultation with the Art Teacher.
 Attention is directed to syllabuses, and to the standing instructions as given in the subject syllabuses.
- Candidates are free to attempt one alternative from either still life or nature.
- Candidates must be instructed that the use of rulers and other mechanical means is not allowed.
- The Art teacher should supply the candidates with cards measuring 5cm wide by 12cm long with which the candidates will demarcate the area in the top right hand corner of the front surface of the paper .In this area, the candidates name, random number and personal numbers, in that order , must be written clearly. This area must not be painted.
- The setter of the groups of objects in this paper must interpret the sides mentioned in the questions set below (ie left or right) according to the position of he candidates facing the objects.



EITHER: STILL LIFE

ALTERNATIVE A:

On a low flat ground, place a chair with metallic stands facing the learners.

On the chair place a medium sized pot (approx 30cm diameter) to face $\frac{3}{4}$ view to your right. This pot is placed on a rounded spiraled cloth on the chair to be stable.

Out of this pot, a long white cloth is made to flow and drape down wards to the front of this composition even covering the left front stand of the chair.

In front of this composition on the floor, on the cloth a pot of the same size is made to lie on this cloth to face ¾ way towards your left.

A gourd with a long neck is placed in front of the opening of this pot in an upright position.

ALTERNATIVE B:

On a low table, near the wall place a saucepan (diameter approx 27cm)

On top of this saucepan place a small mingling stick in a horizontal position.

In front of this saucepan slightly on its left, place a wide shallow dinner plate (diameter approx 30cm)

On this plate a big fresh tilapia fish is placed to face your left.

On the right hand side of the saucepan, place a three litre can of cooking oil with its handle ³/₄ view to your left.

In front of this can, a 500g sachet of salt is randomly placed.

In front of this setting randomly place three tomatoes and a big green pepper.

OR: NATURE

ALTERNATIVE C:

Candidates make a study or studies of a housefly with the help of hand lens.

ALTERNATIVE D:

Candidates draw or paint a landscape with a big tree in the fore ground.

A path is seen near this tree leading to a building in the back ground.
