(b) Show how man today has abused God's aim in regard to the above. (12 marks)
2. (a) Discuss the significance of the massive movements of the Israelites from slavery to the promised land. (13 marks)
(b) Of what relevance is the Exodus event to Christians today? (12 marks)
3. "Sacrifices were essential in the Israelites way of life"
(a) Discuss the above statement in light of the book of Leviticus. (13 marks)
(b) Account for the condemnation of the above institution by the prophets of the time. (12 marks)
4. (a) Analyse the teaching on the concept of love as taught by Moses in Deuteronomy. (13 marks)
(b) Why did the Israelites abuse the privileges of being God's people on reaching the Promised Land? (12 marks)

6. (a) Account for the transfer of the covenant box from Baalah to Jerusalem by King David. (13 marks)
(b) Comment on the nature of God as seen from the above incident. (12 marks)
7. Assess the view that Solomon's good performance was entirely attributed to his father David. (25 marks)

8. (a) Discuss the message Amos received in the five visions. (13 marks)
(b) Comment on Amos' utterances that showed that there would be a remnant among the people of Israel. (12 marks)
